### GENERAL CAST POLICY

### Definitions

- “Cast Member” refers to an individual who is selected to perform as a character or chorus member in a Production.
- “Director” refers to the director of the relevant Production.
- “Production Manager” refers to the production manager of the relevant Production.
- “Production” refers to a theatrical presentation produced by SSP.
- “SSP” refers to Saskatoon Summer Players Inc.

### Cast Selection

1. The selection of Cast Members is governed by SSP Audition Policy (PRO – 0001 – 20160126).

### Rehearsals

2. Cast Members must attend all rehearsals unless permission to miss a rehearsal has previously been granted by the Director.
3. Any Cast Member who misses more than 3 rehearsals may be removed as a cast member and replaced at the discretion of the Director.

### Conditions to Casting

4. In order to be a Cast Member, an individual must:
  - a) review and sign this General Cast Policy and the SSP Code of Conduct and deliver both signed documents to the Production Manager, and
  - b) be an SSP member and have paid any outstanding membership fees no later than the first rehearsal for the Production.

Completion of items 4(a) and 4(b) is a condition to being cast in a Production and an individual who fails to complete either item will be removed as a Cast Member.

## Production Materials

5. All individuals involved in a Production who require a printed copy of the script and/or score (chorus book) for a Production may be required to a) purchase or b) rent the material, by paying an amount to SSP determined by the Production Manager.
