

SSP Patron Vaccination Policy

In line with accepted community standards, Saskatoon Summer Players Inc. will be implementing a vaccination policy of its patrons.

Individuals, aged 12 and older, who choose to patronage a SSP production will be required to show proof of vaccination. Those persons who choose not to or cannot be vaccinated for medical reasons must provide proof of negative test results within 72 hours. You will also be required to show valid, matching, government issued ID.

Patrons between the ages of 12-17 accompanied by an adult over the age of 18 with appropriate ID, are not required to provide ID.

At this time, children under the age of 12 are exempt from vaccination requirements.

SSP will not share, record, or keep a file on proof of vaccinations for patrons. As such, you will be required to provide proof at every production.

Should there be any discrepancies between this and the vaccination policy of the host venue, the latter shall take precedence.

SSP Member and Staff Vaccination Policy

In line with accepted community standards, Saskatoon Summer Players Inc. will be implementing a vaccination policy of its membership.

Members, aged 12 and older, who choose to participate in an SSP production will be required to show proof of vaccination (including a booster dose as eligibility allows).

SSP will not disclose or keep on file a copy of your vaccination record. Upon visual inspection of your verification, the Safety Coordinator (or Board Designate) will simply check off your name on the membership list as having verified your vaccine status.

Members who cannot be vaccinated for bona fide medical reasons or other *Saskatchewan Human Rights Code, 2018*-protected characteristics, may provide the necessary paperwork to the SSP Board to participate. If the documentation provided meets the Board's burden of proof, the Member will be solely responsible for providing the results of the negative PCR Covid test at regular intervals as determined by the SSP Board. All costs associated with the administration and delivery of the PCR tests will be the sole responsibility of the Member and will not be eligible for reimbursement by SSP.
